## wall of hope



The first wall raised in each Building on Faith home is the **Wall of Hope**.

Faith organizations who give \$750+ annually receive a 2x6 Wall of Hope stud.

Keep the stud at your place of worship for members to write messages to the new homeowner, then join us as the Wall of Hope is raised in a family's new home.



## build site opportunities

Everyone is welcome to join us in Building on Faith.

**Individuals** new to Habitat should attend a 30-minute virtual New Volunteer Orientation prior to coming out.

**Groups** wishing to volunteer together must reserve a date in advance.

Faith organizations giving \$1,000+ annually may reserve one day for up to 10 individuals for every \$1,000 donated and may reserve dates up to 9 months in advance.

No donation is required to schedule groups of 5 or fewer.
